The Church Clock was installed on 13th May 1920 with funds raised by Parishoners and dedicated to those men of Bedingfield who gave their lives in the Great War.

The clock is a No 1 Striking DB with a 4ft 6in dial on the South wall of the tower although the striking bell mechanism has not been used for many years, possibly due to complaints from residents.

The clock was supplied by Gillett & Johnston of Croydon and joinery work was undertaken by a local tradesman. The basic cost was understood to have been £50.00
